



## **Diamond Pane Windows**

You will need:

A texture paste or glue which dries clear Mesh ribbon (paper shops usually stock this in silver or gold) Acetate - A piece cut to window size **Black Acrylic Paint** 

## **Small Sharp Scissors**

- Cut out mesh as picture (below left) to create a larger pane for 1/12<sup>th</sup> scale - leave as is for 1/24<sup>th</sup> scale
- Paint mesh with black acrylic on both sides
- Allow to dry
- Apply glue to back of mesh and lay on acetate
- Position so that it is centred correctly
- Cover with a loose piece of plastic (a bag will do) and lay a heavy object on top
- When dry, paint with glue and create swirls in the window if desired

Now you can make up your frames - I use the thin bamboo strips from roll-down blinds which can be cut with a craft knife.
