- **"Balloons"** You can always say it with balloons © Remove or replace the lettering and use variegated colours for a birthday card try the red or teal mix threads for a bit of extra cheer. *Pricking 10 minutes, Stitching approx. 1,5 hours*


#### Work in silky/metallic red

Start with the left curl of the heart and work in crossover stitch (miss 4). Stop and start at the bottom, continue up the right side, until the 'L' is complete.

Then start at the top of the right side of the heart, also in crossover stitch (miss 4). Continue through to the second marker.

Work the 'o' and 'v' in crossover stitch (miss 2).

Start the 'e' from the inside, work in crossover stitch (miss 2), and continue to the second marker (so the section between the two markers are worked twice – once with miss 4 as part of the outline and once with miss 2 as part of the 'e').
