- "Vintage Car #3" Always nice to give a vintage car card to your male friends or relations. Alternatively, it is a good addition to a framed collection of the vintage designs.
  - Pricking 15 minutes, Stitching approx. 2 hours
- "Golf Cart" This one was on our request list and also just in time for the golfing fathers.
  - Pricking 10 minutes, Stitching approx. 2 hours
- "Lighthouse" A Safety beacon perhaps to let someone know you
  are thinking of them during a difficult time. Work it on a coloured card
  to show the white detail.
  - Pricking 15 minutes, Stitching approx. 1,5 hours
- "Nautilus" The pricking may look daunting, but just start by stitching the outside border before doing the ridges

Pricking - 15 minutes, Stitching - approx. 1,5 hours




BS010 Lighthouse Code B



FT051 Vintage Car #3 Code C




FT052 Golf Cart Code C



## \*\*\* Freebie Motif \*\*\* Flip Flops

In this photo we've used turquoise and rainbow metallic thread. Play with any threads you may have!

Soles – Crossover Stitch (miss 2), except the 2 stitches on inside of strap is Stem Stitch (miss 1)

Straps – Stem Stitch (miss 1), starting with a backstitch where the straps are attached to the soles

The encircled dot is an optional pricking to attach a flower sequin.
